

# UNCOMMON YEAR, REMARKABLE IMPACT: NC YMCAS PANDEMIC RESPONSE

Since COVID-19 impacted our Ys and our state in March 2020, our nonprofit YMCAs have continually served to strengthen communities. We shifted facilities and operations to best support and care for children, families, seniors and neighbors in need during the pandemic.

**91,600** wellness calls to seniors and others at risk to lend help and reduce loneliness

Provided remote learning support to **10,175** children at **129** sites to keep students learning (Aug. 2020-March 2021)

Nurtured **32,300** children at **125** emergency child care sites or summer day camps (March-Aug. 2020)

Provided **4,060** children with a safe, supportive and enriching afterschool environment

Served or delivered **981,630** meals to children and families

**8,390** units of blood donated at **310** blood drives

Provided access to **407,660** pounds of healthy produce and held **60** food drives

Made or collected **85,100** PPE items (masks, gloves, etc.) for first responders
